

# Blue Moon & Cabarete Beach

## **Description**

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Blue Moon, run by Eneyda and Guidon, is a retreat center located in the northern mountains near the coastal community of Cabarete. Its unique location allows visitors to enjoy the fresh air and tranquility of the “campo”, with access to one of the most visited beach towns within 20 minutes driving distance. Blue Moon has several “cabins”, each with a sitting area and their own private bathroom. Cabins are basic, but clean and uniquely decorated using local resources. The retreat center has a swimming pool, and bar, and offers food services for an additional cost.



Blue Moon is known for traditional Indian meals of Tandoori Chicken and vegetables, all of which are available upon request. The bustling town of Cabarete, known internationally for wind surfing, is easily accessible by car or taxi.

## **Time Needed**

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Estimated travel time is 3.5 hours one way from Santo Domingo. One overnight is sufficient, however, 2 days will give you the opportunity to enjoy Cabarete as well.

## **Estimated Cost**

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Room rates range from US\$ 40 – US\$ 60 a night and generally fit 2 to 4 people. Breakfast, lunch and dinner prices vary and may range from US\$ 5 – 15 per meal. Indian meals must be reserved in advance.
